

Justice Advocacy Service Rollout at court and legal appointments

The Justice Advocacy Service (JAS) will support adults and young people with cognitive impairment in contact with the NSW criminal justice system, including victims, witnesses and suspects/defendants to exercise their rights and fully participate in the process. **More information about JAS is available in the *Justice Advocacy Service About the Service Fact Sheet*.**

At court and legal appointments, JAS will rollout in two phases. During **phase 1** (commencing 1 July 2019), a JAS support person will be available in the regions listed in **Table 1**. During **phase 2** (commencing 30 August 2019), a JAS support person will be available in the regions listed in **Table 2**.
