



The Government says we must all follow the rules to stay safe

This is to stop coronavirus spreading

The Government says you have to stay home unless you have a good reason to leave



You can only leave your house for things like:



Going to buy things you really need like food or medication



Going for exercise outside, like a walk



If you have to be at a Wedding or Funeral



If you are moving house



Going to and from work



Keeping arrangements about contact between parents and children who don't live together



Taking your children to and from childcare



Going to your doctor



If you need to go to Government offices such as Centrelink

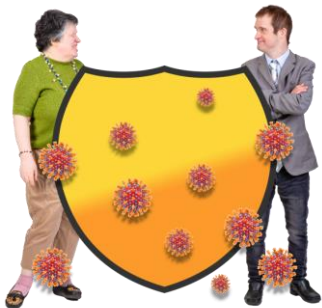


Emergencies like when someone at home is threatening your safety



The Government says we must also stick to new rules if you do go out of your home

You can only go out with one other person, or with the people you live with



You must not stand or walk too close to people

The Government suggests 1.5 metres – or 2 big steps away



The police could fine you if you are doing the wrong thing



A fine is when you must pay money because you have done something wrong



If you don't do what the police say, they could arrest you

Don't argue with the police
