**Justice Advocacy Service (JAS) will make sure you understand what is going on in your matter. We can:**

- ✓ Support you to report a crime to Police
- ✓ Help you get legal advice and meet with your lawyer
- ✓ Attend the Police station if you are under arrest
- ✓ Support you to apply for an AVO
- ✓ Attend Court with you
- ✓ Support you if you are in jail or youth detention
- ✓ Help you talk with solicitors and make sure you understand what is going on through the court process and the outcome

- Medical
- Mental health
- Parenting courses
- Cultural
- NDIS pathways
- Domestic violence support
- Youth
