Justice Advocacy Service (JAS) will make sure you understand what is going on in your matter. We can:

- Support you to report a crime to Police
- Melp you get legal advice and meet with your lawyer
- Attend the Police station if you are under arrest
- Support you to apply for an AVO
- Attend Court with you
- Support you if you are in jail or youth detention
- Melp you talk with solicitors and make sure you understand what is going on through the court process and the outcome





Our support people will do their best to link you with other services you may need, such as:

- Medical
- Mental health
- Parenting courses
- Cultural
- NDIS pathways
- Domestic violence support
- Youth
- Employment
- Housing

JAS Will:

- **Onnect** you with community for ongoing support
